Teachers in partner Schools, Orphanages and Shelters exchange email once a week with Seafarers onboard.

Role – Communicate weekly with Seafarers Onboard. Give pre & post test/survey to Children.

Elementary School Teachers

Match Seafarers and Teachers. Explain program to Teachers including monitoring and evaluation system and tools, including pre and post-test tool.
